

What is <mark>AdapteCCa</mark> ?

AdapteCCa, the Platform on

Adaptation to Climate Change in Spain,

has been created by the Spanish Office for Climate Change and Fundación Biodiversidad, both part of the Ministry for Ecological Transition and Demographic Challenge, to facilitate **consultation and information exchange** on this matter and to strengthen the capacity of society and administrations to adapt, within the framework of the <u>National Climate Change Adaptation Plan (PNACC)</u>.

You can use it to:

- \rightarrow LEARN ABOUT PLANS AND PROGRAMMES for climate change adaptation,
- \rightarrow **OBTAIN INFORMATION** to develop a local adaptation strategy
- \rightarrow ADAPT YOUR ORGANISATION to climate change
- \rightarrow **FIND TOOLS** to host activities to raise awareness
- → ACCESS INFORMATION on impacts, vulnerability and how specific socioeconomic sectors or territories can adapt
- → AND TO STAY UP TO DATE with events, reports and news related to these matters.

POLICIES, PLANS AND PROGRAMS

This section sets out all regulations and planning related to climate change adaptation at all administrative levels, from local to international. Each of them includes an overview of its scope and then displays all the plans available.

INTERNACIONAL The work undertaken by the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC)
and the Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change (IPCC), stands out.

EUROPEAN UNION The European Union's Adaptation Strategy stands out as a guiding framework for the Member States.

NATIONAL The National Climate Change Adaptation Plan is the Spanish State's fundamental legislation on adaptation.

AUTONOMOUS COMMUNITIES You can use the interactive map to consult regional regulations and contact those responsible for them.

LOCAL This section includes analyses of vulnerabilities, municipal plans to address climate change and plans for adaptation

PRACTICAL CASES OF ADAPTATION

The case studies module reflects a selection of <u>more than 40 inspiring initiatives</u> to address climate change adaptation made by public administrations, private sector entities or organisations. These projects range from local to the international scale and deal with the multiple impacts as a result of climate change in Spain. The search engine allows you to filter projects by PNACC sectors, by keywords or by the type of impacts or measures implemented.



This interactive module also connects to <u>Climat-ADAPT</u>, the European adaptation platform, which also has a library of case studies.

CLIMATE CHANGE SCENARIO VIEWER

AEMET, the Spanish Climate Change Office (OECC), CSIC and the Biodiversity Foundation have developed <u>a viewer that shows projections of possible future climate scenarios</u> through the effect of climate change on variables such as temperature or precipitation for different time periods.


RESOURCE FINDE
